

Repeat Cycle Timer



This timer is design to perform timed functions on and off in a 24 hour day. Typically these timers are called repeat cycle timers. This devise is broken up into two parts. A clock and a cycling repeat timer. These timers are designed to cycle a devise on and off during a user defined period. In that period the user has the option of being on and off as many times as they like.

Step 1. Plug in the timer in the electrical power.

Step 2. Set clock to current time.

Step 3. Set tabs for on and off time operations. These tabs are around the rim of the clock. (Over all day of operation.) For example, the user is a mall that wants a devise to operate during the hours of 9 am to 6 pm.

Step 4. Determine the on/off cycle rate.

Step 5. Now set the cycle rate on the cycle. The top two knobs labeled 'Ton', is your time on. The bottom two knobs labeled 'T-off' determine the time off. For example the user wants every 15 minutes to have the devise on for 2 minutes. Here are the settings: Set Ton (white) Knob to 6-60 min. and the Blue Ton knob at 2.5.

Step 6.

Turn on the timer and make sure the devise you are using is also left on.
